CREATIVE TOURISM CHALLENGES

The city becomes a "creative landscape", from being a "machine to live", to be a landscape in which to enjoy, experiment and taste. We can highlight the following aspects of Creative Tourism:

- 2. Active participation of tourists in creative activities, skills development, ... collaboratively with the local population.
- 3. Search for unique and authentic experiences.
- 4. Flows of Culture and Creativity through certain areas of a city or region,
 "the exotic" and "the unknown" in ethnic enclaves.

- 5. The emotional part takes a strong interest in cities and creative territories.
- 6. There is a strong increase in the demand for creative activities and green products, which undoubtedly speak of "new ways of living", of "new ways of consuming" ... "

Creative cities revolve around five keywords: curiosity, imagination, creativity, innovation and invention.
